#### **Research Philosophy and Interests**

I believe that natural history is the cornerstone for all good biological investigations whether empirical, applied, or conservation oriented. Thus, natural history observations form the backbone for all of my research efforts. Besides continuing to publish findings on the life history of tropical butterflies, my current research includes collecting natural history data for birds and a variety of insect groups. My largest current project is the preparation of a field guide to the upland butterflies of north-eastern Ecuador and a collaborative effort on a book covering the natural history of the birds of the Cosanga Valley, also in north-eastern Ecuador. Additionally, I am pursuing multiple studies on the poorly understood behavior of shelter building by the larvae of skipper butterflies. Applying these behavioral and ecological data to theories on skipper taxonomy will be a focus of my future research. On this and other projects I actively encourage and seek out collaborations with scientists from many countries and institutions. This is a reflection of my broad experience and training as a tropical biologist as well as my integrated approach to tackling ecological questions using the diverse backgrounds and expertise of other biologists.

Outside my research, I am actively involved in promoting communication between research biologists and conservationists as well as developing ideas for applying research results to conservation projects.
